As one moves around Convergence, they never see the same view twice. This is because of the light and shadows.

- · Goal: Create a sculpture that shows off the light and shadows of its form.
- Think About Your Structure: Start creating! Using lots of different materials and heights will add different shadows to your sculpture.
- · Hint: You can always use a light nearby (or a bright window) to shine on your sculpture. This will allow you to see how the light creates shadows and bright points.
- Now What? Did you like how the shadows looked when light was shined on your sculpture? If not, try changing just a few small parts of your structure and see if that makes a difference.
